#### What Does COABE Do?

- COABE has led sustained multi year advocacy efforts since 2017
  - Launched the six time award winning "Educate and Elevate" public awareness campaign that showcases student success stories, fact sheets, and videos.
  - Created an award winning State Advocates for Adult Education Fellowship (SAAEF) that teaches state leaders how to talk to mayors, governors, and members of congress
  - Led "Advocacy April" and national "Adult Education and Family Literacy Week"
  - Created the monthly Public Policy Pulse newsletter
  - Works with Congress regularly to revise the law, host legislative events, and ensure adult education is front and center
  - Creates an impact report that celebrates victories




- Continued the advocacy efforts that have been taking place over many years

- Created "Faces of Adult Education" graphics






# What's in the FY26 Budget Proposal?

- The President's "Skinny Budget" zeroes out the \$729 million in federal funding for Adult Education, broken down as follows:
  - \$715.455 million for Adult Education State Grants
  - \$13.712 million for Adult Education National Activities
- "K-12 outcomes will improve as education returns to the States, which would make remedial education for adults less necessary." (FY26 Budget)
- 'The Budget redirects resources to programs that more directly prepare students for meaningful careers." (FY26 Budget)
- "[...] this program has dismal results—in the most recent reported year, only 43 percent of participants had any measurable skills gains." (FY26 Budget)
- "The Budget ends this \$729 million program that incentivizes illegal immigration by furnishing free education, workplace training, and assimilation guidance to aliens whose presence is unlawful." (Open Border Factsheet)



#### **Mobilization**

  - Local programs
  - Adult Learners
  - All possible partners
- Share resources to make advocacy a lighter lift for new advocates.
- We need to all have a unified voice and one clear message.



### The Message

We need Members of Congress to **sign the bipartisan Dear Colleague Letters** in support of adult education funding. These letters show strong backing for programs that help millions of adults earn credentials, improve literacy, and build better futures.

Signing the letter is one of the most impactful ways your representative can protect federal funding for adult education in the FY26 budget.
